Greening Your Victorian House

Exploring ways that energy can be saved in older homes while retaining their architectural features

Most information on saving energy in the home is aimed at houses built since the 1930s and '40s. However, older houses have unique characteristics and architectural features that property owners would prefer to keep which may be affected by using modern energy saving measures. This exhibition and seminar over two days will explore methods and techniques that can be used to make older homes more energy efficient while maintaining their original attributes.
